Vertical Sliding (Sash) UPVC Windows

Characteristics

Heritage profiles developed following extensive consultation with conservation bodies and housing associations

- Traditional timber aesthetics achieved by combining the 35mm putty-line heritage sash with the deep 75mm bottom rail
- Exterior of sash has putty-line aesthetics with matching astragal bar and inside is sculptured with matching astragal bar
- Option of mechanical or fully welded flush sill for tiled or stone sills
- Sash adapter profile available to enable equal sight-lines between top and bottom sashes
- Mullion adapter allows dummy frames to be fixed to a sliding element with the minimum of sight-lines

Appearance

- Available in white for traditional appearance
- A Georgian style shaped glazing bar available both internally and externally
- An all white finish possible using high performance silicone and EPDM seals

Reinforcement

Galvanised steel reinforcement is required above the following parameters:

- For frames over 1000mm width and/or 1300mm height or when no firm fixings to the structure of the building is available
- For sills where the length exceeds 1000mm
- Sashes must always be reinforced



Insulation

- Complies with the requirements of the Building Regulations covering Conservation of Fuel & Power - Part L (England & Wales) and Part J (Scotland) when glazed using the correct type of sealed unit
- Sound insulation is dependent on glazing specification

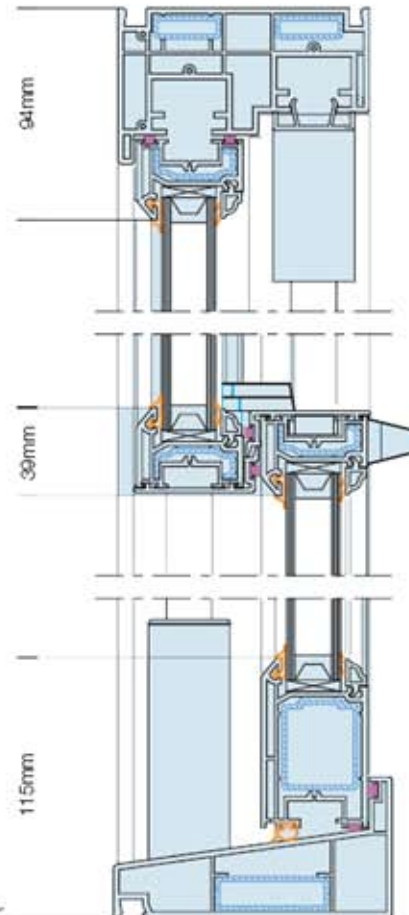
Fittings and Hardware

- Concealed sliding latches enable the sashes to be tilted inwards for ease of cleaning and to be restricted for safety
- Manufacturers recommendations on maintenance should be followed

Glazing

- 24mm double glazing
- Internally glazed sculptured bead for traditional internal joinery detail
- Dry glazed with co-extruded glazing bead
